Many publicists have found that late-year launches offer more accessible opportunities for interviews and features because fewer authors are vying for those spots. Media outlets operate year-round, always in need of fresh stories, so being available when others are not can help your book stand out. If you're planning a launch, consider the unique benefits of targeting these less crowded months.

Summer months present similar advantages. Although spring and fall are traditionally seen as the best seasons for book launches, newsrooms still require compelling content in the summer. With fewer authors promoting their work, you may find it easier to attract interest from editors and producers who are looking for guests and feature topics. Many of the old rules about the best time to launch a book are being challenged as the industry evolves. By being proactive and making yourself available in less competitive periods, you increase your chances of securing valuable media exposure.

Of course, there are exceptions. Some books are inherently time-sensitive and benefit from being launched when public interest naturally peaks. For example, a book about a popular sport may gain the most traction if released at the start of its season. Similarly, aligning your book's launch with annual events or holidays relevant to its subject matter can amplify its impact.
